Feedback from other partner groups included:

A) From Elementary School Principals: looking at changing the timing of the two week winter break to be last week of December and first week of January (allow teachers more rest after holidays)

- B) From Secondary School Prinicipals: need to have at least 3 weeks after winter break to prepare properly for final exams
- C) Trustee Warrington worried about moving forward with approving the calendar 2 years in advance because they might miss changes to dates that would be beneficial to different partner groups. She said this in response to the Elementary School Principal feedback.
- D) Other groups shared strong support for approving the calendar two years in advance and it was noted that feedback from parents has been positive since this practice started.
- E) DPAC (Me) noted that Monday NIDs may be harder than Friday NIDs for families arranging care becauses many families have parents working Monday to Thursday.
- F) DPAC (Me) mentioned that consistency and planning ahead was important to parents so if changes to winter break timing should be done with lots of advance notice and awareness to parents.
