1. Can you tell us how the district intends to deliver on their intention to share the meaning of the Shas Ti Kelly Road Secondary name with the school community and celebrate the opening of the new building?
2. We understand that School Board Trustees and Senior Administration hold meetings with each Family of Schools. Can you share what information is shared at these meetings?
3. Doors are locked according to the District Restart Plan. What will be done on cold or stormy winter weather days? Is there a plan for students to stay inside during their physical/nutrition breaks?
